## Rigid Heddle Looms

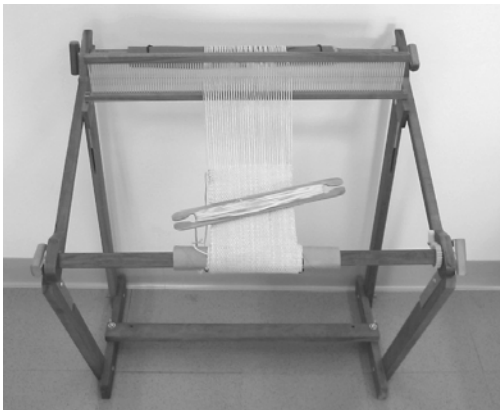
Rigid heddle looms are simple two-harness looms that can be used for many weaving projects. They are great for beginners and those who don't want to spend a large amount of money or take up a lot of space with a larger loom. They are easy to warp and very portable.

These looms are made of cherry wood and finished with Danish oil. The looms come with everything you need to weave: a 10-dent heddle, two shuttles, a pick-up stick, pair of heddle blocks, threading tool and instructions. The looms hold up to a 5-yard warp and come in two weaving widths: 20" or 24".

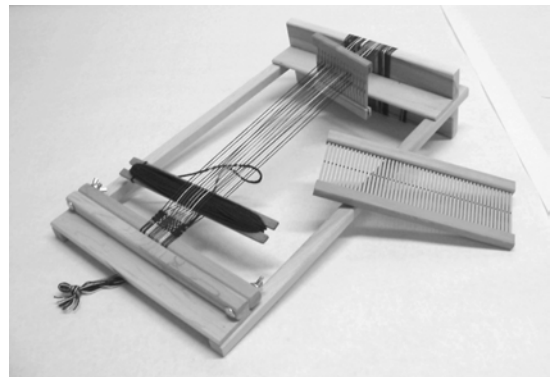
When weaving, the loom is propped up against a table or counter-top. Use of the floor stand allows weaving in any location.

We recommend "Hands On Rigid Heddle Weaving" as a great instructional and reference book. ( see book section of this catalog)

## Table Looms

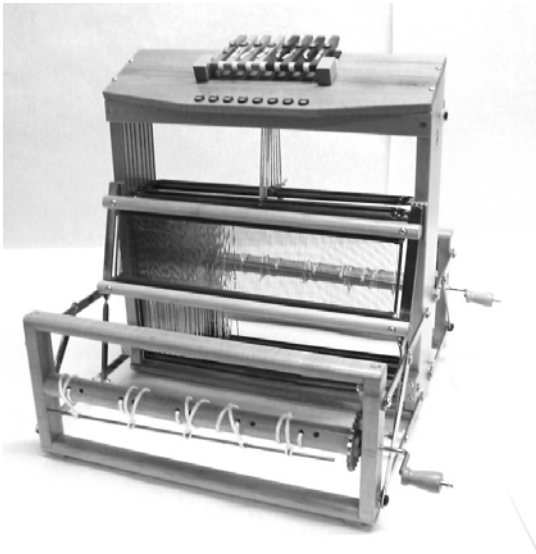
Table looms are multi-harness looms that are easy to warp and portable. Great for quick projects or taking to workshops, the vacation home, or even the deck! These looms are from the LeClerc company of Canada and are made from maple wood.

The looms come with the following standard equipment:

- steel reed - 12 dents / inch
- cherry wood boat shuttle
- reed and heddle hook
- 2 metal lease sticks
- inserted eye heddles
- instructions and "Warp and Weave" book

## Voyageur 15 ¾" - 8 shafts

This is a very portable 8-shaft loom that comes with a denim bag with pouch to hold the loom and all your tools ready for travel. The loom has magnetic shaft levers on the front of the upright and a ratchet brake system. It comes with a stainless steel reed and 400 heddles. This loom weighs 20 ½ pounds.

## Dorothy 24" - 4 shafts

This is a foldable, 4-shaft loom with levers on the right of the upright. It has a friction brake system and comes with 600 heddles. It can be upgraded to 8 or 12 shafts at a later time. This loom weighs 22 pounds.

## Floor Looms

Floor looms are multi-harness looms with treadles that allow the harnesses to be raised or lifted in groups, allowing for efficient pattern weaving. They are generally available in wider widths than other types of looms and have sturdier construction for rug weaving.

The type of loom selected will depend on many things, primarily the projects to be woven on the loom and the floor space available. We do not have all models in stock, but we are distributors for **Norwood, Schacht, Cranbrook, Le-Clerc, Louet,** and **Ashford** looms and we will be pleased to help you select and order a loom based on your needs. We also recommend reading [Learning to Weave](#) by Deborah Chandler to become familiar with the terminology and parts of the loom .

## NORWOOD

These Norwood looms are made by the Toika company of Finland. All looms are finished with a double coat of water-based sealer. All metal parts are precision-machined galvanized steel for smooth operation. These looms have jack-type mechanisms and fold to 28" deep, even when warped, yet the depth when open provides a large shed. The looms come with a stainless steel reed of choice and flat steel or inserted-eye wire heddles, two tie-on bars, lease sticks and complete tie-up system.

Floor Looms: These looms have free-floating lamms, chain tie-up system, and ratchet brake system. They include a 12"x32" adjustable **bench** as standard equipment. Looms are available in 40" or 50" widths with 4 or 8 shafts. 4-shaft looms have 6 treadles, while 8-shaft looms have 12 treadles.

Workshop Looms: These looms are perfect for small spaces, and for transporting to workshops. They are available in a 22" width 4 -shaft model with 4 or 6 treadles. Also available are 30" width 4 or 8-shaft models. The 30" 4-shaft has 6 treadles and the 8-shaft has 10 treadles. The 6 and 10 treadle models have texsolv tie-ups, the 4-treadle model has direct cord tie-ups.
